CONDITIONS

1. The licensee or any one of the person forming the Agency shall successfully undergo training relating to the private security services within 3 months from the date of grant of licence at the Training Institute recognized by the Controlling Authority.
2. The licensee shall intimate the name, parentage, date of birth, permanent address, address for correspondence and the principal profession of each person forming the Agency within fifteen days of receipt of the licence to the Controlling Authority.
3. The licensee shall inform the Controlling Authority regarding any change in address of principal place of business of the Agency or change in the address of persons forming the Agency or change of management within thirty days of such change.
4. The licensee shall immediately intimate to the Controlling Authority about any criminal charge framed against the persons forming the Agency or against a private security guard or supervisor engaged or employed by the Agency, in the course of performance of duties as private security agency. A copy of such communication shall also be sent to the officer in charge of the police station where the person charged against resides.
5. Every licensee shall abide by the requirements of physical standards for the private security guards and their training as prescribed in TS PSAR Rules, 2022, as the condition on which the licence is granted.
6. Ensure verification of character and antecedents of all the private security guards and supervisors as prescribed in Rule 7 of TS PSAR Rules, 2022.
7. Ensure that all the private security guards/supervisors to undergo medical examination once every twelve months as prescribed in Rule 9 (5) of TS PSAR Rules, 2022.
8. The licensee shall commence its activities within six months of obtaining the licence.
9. Commencement of activities shall include establishment of office premises and engagement of supervisors as provided under sub-section (3) of section 9 of the Act and in accordance with rule 10.
10. Save as provided in these rules, the fees paid for the grant of licence shall be non-refundable.
